Breeder's Responsibilities

This puppy is 100% purebred Golden Retriever and can be registered with Limited Registration through the American Kennel Club. Limited Registration does not allow breeding or registering of the offspring. The Buyer will be given the AKC Limited Registration application at the time that possession of puppy is taken.

This puppy is guaranteed to be healthy at the time of sale. The Breeder does not assume any liability or financial responsibility for this puppy for any reason after the Buyer takes possession of the puppy and leaves the premises. All guarantees shall become null and void if the puppy is sold, given away, or transferred to another person (*The only exception to this financial responsibility is under #1 of Buyer's Responsibility with a proven serious illness/life long debilitating defect*).

The Breeder guarantees puppy is Health Checked by a licensed veterinarian before leaving the premises. The puppy has had appropriate vaccinations for its age, and a record of vaccinations, dewormings, and microchip information is supplied to the Buyer. Breeder's guarantee for health does not cover any kind of UTI/parasites/worms such as Coccidia, Giardia or any conditions brought on from the stress of leaving our home and into a new environment.

The Breeder has taken every reasonable precaution to prevent his puppy from acquiring hereditary diseases through thorough veterinarian evaluations of its parents' genetics, and the key areas of the hips, elbows, basic cardiac, and eye exams. From these evaluations, the Breeder assures proper breeding to protect against hereditary disease. However, if the dog develops any verifiable genetic condition then the breeder will take the dog back up to 1 year of age and offer a refund or a replacement puppy.

The Breeder highly recommends that the puppy up to 18 months old should have reasonable limitation on excessive jumping, stairs or running, especially on hard services, due to causing possible hip, shoulder or elbow issues (such conditions as OCD... <https://vcahospitals.com/know-your-pet/osteochondritis-dissecans-or-ocd-in-dogs>), which are known in large breed puppies during

their first year. Veterinary Centers of America states that with OCD... "this disease is more common in dogs receiving too much energy, protein and calcium in the diet. Other factors may also include genetics, rapid growth, trauma, lack of blood flow, and hormonal factors.". None of our Adult Dogs have any genetic history of this disease in their family lineage thus the Breeder will not be responsible for these conditions and highly advises these precautions to be adhered to by the Buyer of the puppy regarding safety, physical activity level and proper diet of the puppy with the goal of preventing these joint issues in their puppy.

Buyer's Responsibilities

The Buyer agrees to have this puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within 2 weeks of taking possession, at Buyer's expense. This is to assure that the puppy has no serious illness or physical defect. If the puppy is determined by a license veterinarian to have a serious illness or life long debilitating physical defect, it is then subject to be returned to Breeder within 5 days of the veterinarian visit at Breeder's cost for either a refund minus the deposit or for a replacement puppy. Written confirmation of health concern and any x-rays or tests from the licensed veterinarian is required to be sent to the Breeder within those 5 days. The Breeder has the right to request a second opinion from a second veterinarian to confirm diagnosis. Should the Buyer fail to have this puppy checked by a license veterinarian within 2 weeks then this guarantee is void.

Temperament and character behavior of each puppy is not guaranteed. We pour great time and effort into the puppy's first 8 weeks to give them a great start in life but it is the Buyer's responsibility to continue to provide:

- ◆ Healthy balanced diet with supplement such as NUVET PLUS
- ◆ Maintain healthy weight
- ◆ Any further procedures/vaccinations that your vet and you decide on for Puppy's health
- ◆ Adequate daily social interaction, exercise and walks
- ◆ Provide a safe, secure environment for puppy
- ◆ Continue positive training of pup through self study or classes
- ◆ If neutering then after 1 year of age

Payment:

Deposit must be made at time of reserving a puppy and is non-refundable. Payment for Puppy must be paid in full before Puppy leaves Breeder's possession. Payment can be made through Cash, Venmo, Credit Card (through GoodDog.com with additional fees), Bank Transfer (through GoodDog.com no-fee), or Postal Money Order.

This document represents the entire agreement between the Breeder and the Buyer of the Puppy. No other promises or guarantees are made. The conditions of this agreement may only be changed in writing by mutual consent of both parties.

The Buyer has read and understands the Puppy Purchase Agreement with Limited Registration in its entirety and agrees that all parts and portions thereof constitute a binding agreement. Further, signatures below acknowledge agreement and receipt of this agreement by both parties.
